

Code of Conduct

Every parent/guardian and camper must read and consent to FUTURE VET KIDS CAMP Code of Conduct.

The Code of Conduct is rooted in four core values: respect, responsibility, honesty and compassion.

FUTURE VET KIDS CAMP promotes responsibility, respect and civility in a safe learning and fun camp environment.

A positive camp culture exists when all members feel safe, included and accepted and actively promote positive behaviours and interactions.

These standards of behaviour extend to all individuals involved in the FUTURE VET KIDS CAMP community, including; parents, presenters and staff whether they are on school property, on school buses, at off-site venues or in any other circumstances that could have an impact on the camp climate.

As participants of FUTURE VET KIDS CAMP, all campers agree to and understand the following:

- They are to show respect for themselves, their fellow campers, staff, animals, the environment, camp facilities and property.
- FUTURE VET KIDS CAMP has a Zero Tolerance policy towards physical violence and non-physical bullying/aggression. Any camper causing harm, or intending to do so to any other camper, staff member or animal **WILL BE SENT HOME WITHOUT REFUND.**
